**morning**, mornings [ˈmɔːnɪŋ]

(noun)

**Definition:** the part of the day after midnight and before midday

**Example:** I wake up at 7 in the morning.

**Antonym(s):** evening



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## in the morning

(Chunk)

**Example:** I wake up at 7 in the morning.

**noon**, noons [nuːn]

(noun)

**Definition:** twelve o'clock in the day, midday

**Example:** We have a break at noon.

## at noon

(Chunk)

**Example:** We have lunch at noon.

**afternoon**, afternoons [ˌæftəˈnuːn]

(noun)

**Definition:** the part of the day which follows noon, between noon and evening

**Example:** I do my homework in the afternoon.

## in the afternoon

(Chunk)



*Example:* I talk to my friends in the afternoon.

**evening**, evenings [ˈiːvɪŋɪŋ]

(noun)

*Definition:* the time of the day between dusk and night, when it becomes dark

*Example:* I go to sleep in the evening.

*Antonym(s):* morning

**in the evening**

(Chunk)

*Example:* We have dinner in the evening.

**night**, nights [naɪt]

(noun)

*Definition:* the time between sunset and sunrise

*Example:* I sleep at night.

**at night**

(Chunk)

*Example:* We celebrate at night.

**midnight** [ˈmɪdˌnaɪt]

(uncountable noun)

*Definition:* the middle of the night, twelve o'clock at night

*Example:* She called me at midnight.

**at midnight**

(Chunk)

*Example:* Meet me at midnight.
