



campsite	a place where a tent may be pitched
camp	to live in a tent or similar temporary accommodation, usually outdoors
go camping	
sleeping bag	a padded or insulated bag large enough to surround the whole body and which keeps the user warm while sleeping, used as a substitute for bedclothes
tent	a pavilion or portable lodge consisting of skins, canvas, or some strong cloth, stretched and sustained by poles, used for sheltering persons from the weather
caravan	a furnished vehicle towed behind a car and used as a dwelling when stationary, e.g. at a campsite
camper	a motor vehicle with a rear compartment for living and sleeping in
compass	a magnetic or electronic device used to determine the cardinal directions
hike	a long walk through nice scenery
hiker	one who hikes, especially frequently
