disabled person	a person with a disability
physically handicapped	having an absence of competent physical power
mentally handicapped	having an absence of competent intellectual or moral power
sane	being in a healthy condition; possessing a rational mind; having the mental faculties in such condition as to be able to anticipate and judge the effect of one's actions in an ordinary manner
insane	a disorder of mind; not having the mental faculties in such condition as to be able to anticipate and judge the effect of one's actions in an ordinary manner
impaired hearing	not being able to properly hear sounds
deaf	not being able to hear
paralysed	not being able to move
